**Report from the Honorary Secretary**

Dear members,

First of all I convey my season's greetings to all of you in this 27<sup>th</sup> Annual General Meeting 2016. It gives me immense pleasure to present before you the report of the work done by the present committee. The present committee took over charges in the month of October' 2015 and has completed one year.

**Administrative:** Our membership strength as on September'2016: F=34, M=119 &AM= 131  
Total= 284 members.

During this one year period, this committee has convened 10 Local Committee Meetings, performed technical activities, took initiatives for construction of the new office building- construction work of the building has already started and the work is under progress.

The committee has organised the following major events:

1. Observation of 27<sup>th</sup> Foundation Day (28<sup>th</sup> Jan'2016)

27<sup>th</sup> Foundation Day of the Institution of Engineers (India), Silchar Local Centre, was celebrated with full dignity and gaiety. The day long program was celebrated in two sessions. In the first session The Institution's flag was hoisted at 9 am followed by a discussion session among the members present. During this period, this committee has convened 12 (twelve) Local Committee Meetings, performed technical activities, took initiatives for construction of the office building which is yet to take shape because of unavoidable reasons.

**Technical Activities** : The committee has organized the following major events:—

- ▶ **Regional Workshop on Role of IPR on Innovation in Electronics, Communication, Computing & Devices in collaboration with Tezpur University IPR Cell was held on 27-28 November 2013.**

The above workshop was sponsored by Department of Electronics and Information Technology (DeitY), Government of India. The two-day workshop covers the aspects related to Role of Intellectual Property Rights in ICT; use of Copyright and Trademarks to protect innovations in ICT; litigations related to Copyright and Trademarks in ICT Sectors; use of Patents to protect innovations in ICT; how to search Patent Information; how to manage Innovations and IPR in an Academic Institution.

The workshop was attended by the Faculty Members, PG Students and PhD Scholars of Assam University and NITS, Working Engineers and Entrepreneurs of Barak Valley. The resource persons were Prof. P. - ▶ **One day interactive and hands on session on Nerve Therapy was held on 26 June 2014.**

At the outset, I convey festive greetings to you all. After being installed on 12<sup>th</sup> October, 2007 the present committee has completed a year. During this long twelve months, it has been our endeavour to continue not only with our mandatory jobs but

also to carry on with different other technical activities mainly such technical activities which are related to the local problems. The activities performed are highlighted below.

During the above mentioned period, total numbers of Local Committee Meeting convened was ten and number of Lecture Meeting held on different topics was five, besides celebrating the mandatory requirement of (i) 19<sup>th</sup> Foundation Day of Silchar Local Centre on 17<sup>th</sup> February, 2008, (ii) World Telecommunication Day on 17<sup>th</sup> May jointly with Bharat Sanchar Nigam Limited, Silchar, (iii) World Environment Day on 5<sup>th</sup> June, 2008 with Pollution Control Board, Assam and (iv) 41<sup>st</sup> Engineers Day on 15<sup>th</sup> September, 2008.

Different topics discussed in our lecture meeting are as follows :

- 1) 13-10-2007 Lecture on Vertical Axis wind turbine for small & large scale power production.
- 2) 25-11-2007 Lecture on Power Crisis aggravated by the depletion of the natural gas from Barak Valley.
- 3) 16-12-2007 Lecture on NATRIP in the development of N.E. Region.
- 4) 08-03-2008 Lecture on Bio-Technology and its Extending Horizon.
- 5) 25-07-2008 Lecture on building team spirit & human relationship.

In addition to the above mentioned technical activities, Silchar Local Centre has organized a seminar on „Communication Bottleneck in the development of Barak Valley“ on 27-04-2008 as a part of Golden Jubilee Celebration of Assam State Centre, Guwahati. Chariman and other dignitaries of Assam State Centre attended the Seminar. BRTF, N. F. Railway and National Highway Authority of India presented papers. Resolutions taken in

that seminar were sent to the authorities for implementation. It may be mentioned here that this local Centre for the first time organized state level seminar and more than 100 Engineers participated.

Further a workshop on “Detection of Forged Currency Notes” was organized at this Centre for awareness with the help of Reserve Bank of India, Guwahati. People from all sections of our society participated in that workshop held on 25<sup>th</sup> February, 2008. UBI, LICI and Assam Gramin Vikash Bank sponsored the programme. So our Local Centre did not confine in only technical activities but also addressed other burning issues.

A field trip was organized on 15<sup>th</sup> November, 2007 to DLF, Adamtilla to assess the problems faced by the Power Generation Company in getting natural gas from ONGCL. Findings were placed in the meeting held on 25<sup>th</sup> November, 2007. You will be glad to know that due to our initiative, ONGCL brought Workover Rig from upper Assam and two wells were repaired – as a result gas production of ONGCL improved. Power generation at Adamtilla also improved to a great extent.

Earthquake Resistant Design Cell & Helpline was opened by Hon<sup>ble</sup> Union Minister Shri S. M. Dev on 23<sup>rd</sup> February, 2008 to implement the resolution taken earlier. As this valley being situated in earthquake prone zone-v, it will help the people of this valley to construct houses earthquake resistant.

Construction of building for Counselling & Information Centre was completed which was opened by Hon<sup>ble</sup> Union Minister Shri S. M. Dev on 23<sup>rd</sup> February, 2008. It may be mentioned here that an amount of Rs. 2.00 lacs was donated by Hon<sup>ble</sup> Union Minister Shri S. M. Dev from his MPLAD fund.

As per resolution taken in last Local Committee Meeting, today we have opened our library in the name of late Er. Satyendra Kumar Dubey at this Centre. Prof. Nikhilesh Paul donated 103 Nos. of books and a steel almirah in the name of his departed father. We sincerely thank him. It is expected that within short time, all the necessary books as per AMIE syllabus will be procured to guide the AMIE students.

From the session 2008-09 we will be able to award "Kalikrishna-Mrinalini Gold Medal" to the best student of NIT, Silchar. An amount of Rs. 1.0 lac donated by Dr. K. D. Krori and family has been kept in fixed deposit with Assam Gramin Vikash Bank, Itkhola, Silchar and with the interest generated, we will be able to award Gold Medal every year to the Silchar NIT Topper. We sincerely thank Dr. K. D. Krori and his family members for the same.

We were able to partially develop our low lying vacant land of this Centre in this session. Our senior member Er. S. R. Swami has come forward and constructed a culvert over the municipal drain for the entry of trucks etc. into the vacant land at his own cost. Premier Oil donated more than 200 trucks of soil and transported the same to fill up the low lying area of our centre. 2/3<sup>rd</sup> low lying area was thus filled up. It is expected that within next year, we will be able to fill remaining low lying area of this centre. We are thankful to our member Er. S. R. Swami and Premier Oil for their help.

The Local Centre is continuing its AMIE coaching in the centre itself. Vocational training course for repairing of 2/3 wheeler and Plumbing and Sanitary Fitting have been completed for two batches. We have also published two volumes of News Letter in this session.

We must improve the membership scenario of the centre. I now request you that each of us should induct atleast five graduate engineers for membership within a month. If we all exert, our membership scenario will definitely improve soon.

You will be glad to know that we are keeping the local centre open daily from 12 Noon to 8 p.m. Full credit for these activities goes to our Chairman of the Local Centre Er.

K. K. Dutta and other dedicated members of this centre. I personally will remain thankful to my Chairman for his dedicated, dynamic and selfless service for the cause of the Local Centre.

Dear members, there are many other things where we fail to fulfill your expectation. Publication of report of our activities in the News Letter published by the Head Quarter may be one such example. However, we will do the needful to reduce our shortfalls.

Before I conclude, I take this opportunity to thank you all for your support and cooperation and hope the same in future also. After all, we all feel proud for any

good of our Silchar Local Centre.
